Amdt. 4 to HR.4899 Lee (D-CA)	Amend Afghanistan supplemental military appropriation to provide funds only for withdrawal of troops
Amdt. 5 to HR.4899 McGovern (D-MA)	Amend Afghanistan supplemental military appropriation to require the Administration to set a timeline for withdrawal of troops
HR.4899 Obey (D-WI)	Provide \$33 billion in supplemental funds to increase troop levels in Afghanistan from 67,000 to 100,000
H.Res. 278 McGovern (D-MA)	Address the threat of international terrorism and protect international security by reducing the number of and accessibility to nuclear weapons and preventing their proliferation, and directing the resulting savings towards child survival, hunger & universal education.
H.Res. 333 Woolsey (D-CA)	Recognizing non-proliferation options and upholding U.S. obligations under the United Nations' Non-Proliferation Treaty.
Sign-On Letter Ellison (D-MN), McDermott (D-WA)	This sign-on "Dear Colleague" letter calls Pres. Obama's attention to the devastating humanitarian impact of Israel's illegal blockade of the occupied Gaza Strip. Among its demands are granting Gazans access to clean water, fuel, and medical supplies.
Sign-On Letter Frank (D-MA), Paul(R-TX)	This sign-on letter calls on the Deficit Reduction Commission to include reductions in military spending along with other possible savings areas to reduce the deficit.
Out of Afghanistan Caucus Conyers (D-MI)	The caucus groups members of the House of Representatives who seek to quickly and responsibly end military operations in Afghanistan, while bolstering the United States' diplomatic efforts
