At home the US war machine is tearing apart our society. Nearly 4,000 U.S. service people have been killed and over 40,000 are wounded, many of them neglected by our own government. Ignoring our protests against massive cuts to social programs, the US government instead is pouring upwards of \$3 trillion into war and empire-building – into expanding its political and economic power over the people of the world.

The US is devastating Iraq and Afghanistan, threatening Pakistan and Iran, and at the same time, is fighting a war against poor people and communities of color, both in the US and throughout the world. These wars are in fact one and the same, and each of them fuels the other. We must put an end to both.
